The West Hills Community College District Board of Trustees, through the Chancellor, develops faculty responsibilities that support student success and the missions and visions of the District and its colleges. These responsibilities ensure that high quality educational opportunities are available to students and the communities served by the District.

Faculty members are those employees who are employed by the District in academic positions that are not designated as administrators or management. Faculty employees include, but are not limited to, instructors, counselors, librarians, and specified professionals in health services, DSPS, and EOPS. Faculty positions are those positions for which minimum qualifications for service have been established by the Board of Governors for the California Community Colleges.

Through a regular evaluation process, the District ensures that all faculty carry out these responsibilities and are afforded staff development opportunities to maintain the quality of academic programs and services. Faculty responsibilities are regularly evaluated for currency and relevance.
