



Board Policy 3540 Sexual and Other Assaults

Reference: *Education Code Section 67382, 67385;*
20 U.S.C. Section 1092(f);
34 C.F.R. Section 668.46(b)(11)

Any sexual assault or physical abuse including, but not limited to, rape as defined by California law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public, and which occurs on District property, is a violation of District policies and procedures and is subject to all applicable punishments, including criminal procedures and employee or student discipline procedures.

Students and employees who may be victims of sexual and other assaults are treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance. The Chancellor or his/her designee has established administrative procedures that help ensure that students and employees who are victims of sexual and other assaults receive appropriate information and treatment. The procedures for sexual and other assaults shall meet the criteria contained in Education Code Section 67385 and 34 C.F.R. Section 668.46.
