REPORTS FROM ORGANIZATIONS /COLLEGES / DISTRICT OFFICE

<u>Academic Senate Report</u> – Mr. Marlon Hall, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Coalinga, reported that Dr. Allen Carden of the Central Valley Higher Education Consortium (CVHEC) was the guest speaker at the October 12 Academic Senate meeting in Coalinga. Discussion occurred with Dr. Carden regarding the guaranteed AA transfer degree and the Academic Senate adopted a resolution concerning this matter which Mr. Hall read to the Board of Trustees. Mr. Hall reported that he is looking forward to making a presentation to the Board of Trustees at their January retreat.

Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Lemoore, was not present to report at this time.

<u>WHCFA Report</u> – In the absence of Mr. John Bart, WHCFA President, Ms. Faye Mendenhall stated that the Faculty Association had nothing to report at this time.

<u>CSEA Report</u> – Mr. Tony Garcia, CSEA President, was not present to report at this time.

<u>ASB Report</u> – Mr. Willie Lee, Student Trustee, reported that the student government has been busy with many activities including a forum on ethical issues with SIFE; first annual fun day in Lemoore; Jim Costa visit; Open House; and a Halloween dance.

<u>West Hills College Coalinga and North District Center, Firebaugh</u> – Dr. Anthony Tricoli, President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. Dr. Tricoli acknowledged the efforts of Mr. Marlon Hall and stated that his leadership is important. Dr. Tricoli reported that he recently attended a conference on major gift fundraising and will continue work in this area.

Dr. Beverly Smith, Dean of Student Learning, commented on the final editing of the accreditation self study. She reported that there is documentation and extensive data for every area. The self study shows the autonomy of the college and shows collaborative, shared governance decision making. The self study also shows that the college mission is central to planning.

<u>West Hills College Lemoore</u> – Mr. Don Warkentin, Interim President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. On behalf of Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President for West Hills College Lemoore, he reminded the Board that their Senate has also passed a resolution on the guaranteed AA degree. He also reported that the Lemoore Senate is presently reviewing the Chancellor's office recommendations for the curriculum process.

Mr. Warkentin reported that the accreditation process for Lemoore is moving forward. All full time faculty have volunteered and are assigned to a standard. They will have in excess of 60 staff members working on accreditation.

Ms. Marta Hendrickson, Counselor at West Hills College Lemoore, provided a PowerPoint presentation on articulation. President Levinson stated that articulation is an interesting process. Trustee Minnite questioned if the four year institutions are asking for more of the information from the community colleges. Ms. Hendrickson responded in the affirmative stating that more courses have been added. Dr. Gornick stated that anything we can do to simplify the process is going to help people transfer.

<u>Chancellor's Report</u> – Dr. Frank Gornick, Chancellor, thanked Dr. Tricoli, Mr. Warkentin, and their staff. He reported that he has read the accreditation document for West Hills College Coalinga and it is well done and thorough. He stated that we are off to a good start in terms of the numbers.
