MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL ORGANIZATION MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BOARD

December 7, 2004



CALL TO ORDER / OPEN SESSION

President Levinson called the meeting of the Board of Trustees to order at 2:10 p.m.

REPORTS FROM ORGANIZATIONS /COLLEGES / DISTRICT OFFICE

<u>Academic Senate Report</u> – Mr. Marlon Hall, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Coalinga, reported that the Senate has recommended Anita Whitehead and Michael Burke for NISOD recognition. In addition, the Senate has approved the accreditation self study document. Mr. Hall reported that the Senate recently adopted the following resolution:

Whereas, the Academic Senate of West Hills College Coalinga recognizes the positive influence, exemplary teaching, and leadership exhibited by Norine Oliver as a member of the faculty for 25 years; and Whereas, the Academic Senate of West Hills College Coalinga believes that high recognition is in order for our departed colleague; and Whereas, the Academic Senate of West Hills College Coalinga recognizes October 8 as Norine Oliver Day. Therefore, be it resolved that the Academic Senate of West Hills College Coalinga agrees to adopt this date as one of honor and praise for Mrs. Norine Oliver, faculty emeritus.

Mr. Hall commented that flex day activities are currently being planned and many workshops and breakout sessions are on the agenda for the day. He stated that at the last Board meeting, Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President for Lemoore, commented that the AA degree requirements for English and math are being changed. Mr. Hall stated that he checked on this and the changes have been tabled and will be discussed further at the Academic Senate plenary session in the spring.

Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Lemoore, was not present to report at this time.

<u>WHCFA Report</u> – Mr. John Bart, WHCFA President, was not present to report at this time.

<u>CSEA Report</u> – Mr. Tony Garcia, CSEA President, was not present to report at this time.

<u>West Hills College Coalinga and North District Center, Firebaugh</u> – Dr. Anthony Tricoli, President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. Dr. Tricoli also briefly commented on his recruiting trip to Sweden and Italy.

<u>West Hills College Lemoore</u> – Mr. Don Warkentin, Interim President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events.

<u>Chancellor's Report</u> – Dr. Frank Gornick, Chancellor, reported on a new feature of the website that has been implemented. Mr. Pedro Avila, Director of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Web Services, demonstrated the online registration feature which now includes the ability to pay for classes online. Mr. Avila also demonstrated the use of the electronic transcript procedure.

At this time Trustee Henry arrived.

Dr. Gornick reported that the District recently received the Chancellor's Diversity Award. The District was honored for increasing the diversity of its administrative staff by the largest percentage of any community college district in the state for the last ten years.

CO-12 <u>Accreditation Self Study – West Hills College Coalinga</u> – Dr. Beverly Smith, Dean of Student Learning, reported that several of the comments that were made by Board members at the last meeting were incorporated into the final accreditation document.

> The Accreditation Self Study for West Hills College Coalinga was approved on a motion by Trustee Ivans, seconded by Trustee Henry, and carried unanimously.

FISCAL SERVICES

Mr. Ken Stoppenbrink, Interim Vice Chancellor of Business Services, introduced Mr. Keven Backman who is serving as the Interim Director of Human Resources. Mr. Stoppenbrink stated that he has good background and knowledge in the human resources area. Dr. Gornick stated that Mr. Backman is quite familiar with the Datatel system.

FS-21	<u>Fiscal Services Report</u> – Mr. Stoppenbrink distributed the budget status report and briefly discussed the status of the budget expenses and revenues.
FS-22	<u>Federal Surplus Property Program</u> – The eligibility renewal application for the federal surplus property program was approved on a motion by Trustee Ivans, seconded by Trustee Levinson, and carried unanimously.
FS-23	<u>Resolution – Redeposit of Payroll Distribution</u> – Mr. Stoppenbrink reported that the Redeposit of Payroll Distribution resolution allows that through the resolution, anyone who previously paid into STRS and cashed it out can purchase years of service credit through the District. The resolution authorizes the deduction.
	The resolution in the matter of the redeposit of payroll distribution was adopted on a motion by Trustee Cantu, seconded by Trustee Minnite, and carried unanimously.
FS-24	<u>Change Order</u> – Mr. Stoppenbrink distributed a project budget review and explained the contingency account. Discussion took place regarding the contingency funds.

 - Item 2 Library stacks, racks and shelves bid awarded to Ross McDonald Company in the amount of \$73,568.68. Pricing as per GSA-28F-1120C (SIN 486-9 thru 14) contract.
 - Item 3 Library office furniture and equipment to California Business Furnishings in the amount of \$8,929.89. Pricing as per U.S. Communities Agreement No. N001593.
