Use of smoking and smokeless tobacco products including cigarettes, cigars, little cigars, chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff, and any electronic device that delivers nicotine or other vaporized liquids to a person inhaling from the device (e.g., e-cigarettes and vaporizers) are prohibited in all District owned, occupied, or leased buildings and prohibited within 20 feet of a main exit, entrance, or operable window of all District owned, occupied, or leased buildings and in areas so designated. In addition, the possession or use of marijuana in all District owned, occupied, or leased buildings is prohibited under federal law and the District's current policies.

Priority shall be given to a smoke-free learning, working and living environment.

Under no circumstances will the use of marijuana, smoking, or the use of smokeless tobacco products, including cigarettes, cigars, little cigars, chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff, and any electronic device that delivers nicotine or other vaporized liquids to a person inhaling from the device (e.g., e-cigarettes and vaporizers) be permitted in classrooms, laboratories or libraries. All other indoor facilities, including employee work areas and offices, conference rooms, restrooms, cafeteria, residence halls and lounge areas, shall be non-smoking areas and outside hazardous areas specifically identified as non-smoking areas. Additionally, marijuana, smoking, or smokeless tobacco products may not be used within 250 feet of a youth sports event. A youth sports event is any practice, game, or related activity organized by any entity at which athletes up to 18 years of age are present.

Following a careful review of environmental conditions, the Risk Management Committee may designate and post selected outside locations as non-smoking areas.

Smoking permitted areas shall be subject to periodic review and possible change, but in no case shall the use of marijuana be permitted.

Signs shall be displayed indicating that smoking is prohibited in all indoor facilities and designated outside areas.
