Consistent with federal regulations pertaining to federal financial aid eligibility, the Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Institutional Effectiveness will ensure that the District complies with the United States Department of Education's disclosure requirements for each of the District's gainful employment programs, by disclosing federally-mandated information about the programs to prospective students. The District shall make the required disclosures available to prospective students in promotional materials and on its website.

The Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Institutional Effectiveness shall establish practices to ensure that the colleges meet these reporting requirements whenever the colleges intend to add a new gainful employment program.
